Arnold Wesker: Three plays (Chicken soup with Barley - Roots - I'm talking about Jerusalem). (Wesker was one of the wild young British authors of dramas in the 50s and 60s - "Angry young men" and all that...)

Donna Leon: Through a glass darkly. Crime Novel, set in Venice.

Joseph Kanon: Alibi. Historical thriller set in Venice in 1946.

Ernest Hemingway: True at first light. Hemingway's final novel.

David Henry Wilson: Elephants don't sit on cars. Adventures with Jeremy James. Children's book.

Ellis Peters et al.: Räuber, Schurken, Lumpenpack. Historische Kriminalgeschichten. (Dicker Band voll mit Geschichten die besonders junge Leser fesseln werden)
